

Summary of 2023 Grants

2023-1 RODA Wind Energy \$15,000.00

Responsible Offshore Development Alliance (RODA) represents fishermen, processors, and marine related businesses seeking to have input in the development of offshore wind energy projects in the U.S. This grant help fund the expansion of RODA to include a west coast employee working with the west coast seafood industry.

2023-2 Seafood Harvesters of America \$2,500.00

Seafood Harvesters of America is a National lobby organization working in Washington D.C. monitoring legislation which could impact the seafood industry.

2023-3 Scholarship Fund \$10,000

This grant provided \$5,000 to the Commercial Fishermen's Wives of Humboldt and \$5,000 to the Del Norte Scholarship Foundation to provide scholarships to the children of parents or grandparents involved in the fishing industry.

2023-4 OSU/PSMFC Gear Technology \$30,000.00

Oregon State University and the Pacific States Marine Fisheries Commission have been involved in fishing gear technology projects for many years. This grant helps offset the cost of graduate students enrolled in OSU's gear technology program.

2023-5 CCCA Whale Status \$10,000.00

California Coastal Crab Association has hired marine biologist to explore whether the population of Humpback whales has grown sufficiently to warrant removal from the endangered species list. This grant helps offset this cost.

2023-6 Navigation and Communications \$\$41,400

This grant provided funding to qualified fishermen to help offset the cost of upgrading their navigational and communication equipment to better identify their location at sea in

relationship to the location of the fiber optics cables and to better communicate with other fishermen or if needed the snag hot line.
